Agriculture continues to play a major role in the economy of Tehama County. For this reason, the Dairyville Community Club has made a commitment to assist college students who are majoring in the field of agriculture. We are pleased to announce that \$20,000 has been allocated for scholarships and all qualified students are encouraged to apply. Scholarship amounts vary depending on the number of qualified applications received from former Lassen View School students graduating from High School and Agricultural Studies students.

The Agricultural Studies Scholarships are divided into two categories; Upper Division and Graduate. Upper Division scholarships will be awarded to college students majoring in agriculture. Applicants must be a junior or greater class rank in the fall of 2024. The Agricultural Scholarship Program has been expanded to also include students pursuing a graduate or doctoral degree in agriculture. To be eligible for either of these scholarship programs, the applicants must be a past graduate of a Tehama County High School. All scholarship funds awarded will be made available for use during the 2024/2025 academic school year. In order to be considered, Upper Division students must take at least 12 units of courses each semester and Graduate students must be enrolled in 9 units each semester.

All of the following items must be received by the Dairyville Community Club Scholarship Committee postmarked on or before the April 12, 2024 deadline for consideration:

1. The two page Upper-Division Agricultural Studies Scholarship Application
2. A copy of all college transcripts indicating all college work completed to date and a current course of study.
3. Two letters of recommendation that give information about your character, ability, and interest in the field of agriculture.
 - One recommendation should come from a college professor/lecturer or advisor. The second should be from someone that is not a family member. These recommendations can be submitted with the other application materials or can be mailed directly to the committee by the person making the recommendation, but either way, they must be postmarked on or before the April 12, 2024 deadline. *
4. A one-page essay which includes the following:
 - Autobiography
 - Your career plans following graduation
5. An essay, up to two pages in length, which includes/addresses the following:
 - In your opinion, what is the future of agriculture in Tehama County?
 - Select an important issue facing agriculture in Tehama County and briefly outline a program that you might undertake to address that issue.
6. A photograph of yourself to be used for a Scholarship Display at the Dairyville Festival and printed in the Dairyville Newsletter.
